MARY MORROW'S HARD WORKING VOLUNTEERS

Mary Morrow's Attic in Sparta isn't just a resale store. Donations are accepted and money raised is donated to the Morrow Home and needy families in the area. The women are pictured in front of one of the high-low electric beds that Mary Morrow's Attic purchased for the Morrow Home. In recent months, using funds from the Attic, eight of the high-low beds have been purchased, as well as an EZ lift, that can handle up to 600 pounds; a shower gurney; a wheelchair scale; an electric door for the doorway between Homestead and the courtyard; and several smaller items, for a total of over \$20,000. Items that are able to be resold and are not soiled or damaged can be donated to Mary Morrow's Attic, 116 S. Water Street. The store cannot accept electronics or large appliances.
